Author Ethical Guidelines

Optics Journal (Opt. J.) welcomes original contributions to the field of optics, lasers, and related sciences. **Opt. J.** is committed to rapid, fair, and impartial refereeing. Authors submitting manuscripts to **Opt. J.** are assumed to be acting within the following ethical framework:

1. The manuscript *is original* and has not been submitted elsewhere.
2. The manuscript reports on results previously unpublished.
3. The manuscript reports on work performed by the author(s).
4. Experimental results, theoretical work, and statements, included in the manuscript are presented in good faith.
5. All claims made in the manuscript are supported by the disclosed data.
6. The manuscript cites relevant references in the field.
7. The manuscript references previously published relevant data and clearly describes differences and/or improvements over the existing literature. In addition, *Optics Journal* encourages, at the introduction, the inclusion of one or two historical references that would give a fair indication of the origin of the subject matter being considered.
8. The use of exaggerated language is discouraged.
9. A clear and unambiguous description on *what is new* is included in the abstract.
