Optics Journal (**Opt. J.**) welcomes original contributions to the field of optics, lasers, and related sciences. **Opt. J** is committed to rapid, fair, and impartial refereeing. Authors submitting manuscripts to **Opt. J.** are assumed to be acting within the following ethical framework:

- 1. The manuscript is original and has not been submitted elsewhere.
- 2. The manuscript reports on results previously unpublished.
- 3. The manuscript reports on work performed by the author(s).
- 4. Experimental results, theoretical work, and statements, included in the manuscript are presented in good faith.
- 5. All claims made in the manuscript are supported by the disclosed data.
- 6. The manuscript cites relevant references in the field.
- 7. The manuscript references previously published relevant data and clearly describes differences and/or improvements over the existing literature. In addition, *Optics Journal* encourages, at the introduction, the inclusion of one or two historical references that would give a fair indication of the origin of the subject matter being considered.
- 8. The use of exaggerated language is discouraged.
- 9. A clear and unambiguous description on what is new is included in the abstract.
